

### **Tree N3A: Samuel KISBY of Polebrook and Sarah (of Winnick) and descendants**

Samuel KISBY is described as “of Polebrook” (Northamptonshire) at the time of his marriage in 1766, but evidently settled in Winnick/Winwick, Huntingdonshire to bring up his family. A Thomas KISBY “of Polebrook” marries in Little Stukely, Hunts., in 1764, possibly a brother. They may both be sons of Thomas and Sarah KISBY of Winwick, who baptised several children in the 1740s.

 bur. 31 January 1879, Sutton Bridge (St Matthew).

**SWANNELL  
 Mary Moss**

born c. May 1838, Pavenham, Bedfordshire,<sup>24</sup> to an educated family.<sup>25</sup> Mary is a first cousin of Mary Moss WOODRUFF.  
 died 5 May 1897 aged 57, Birmingham, Warwickshire.<sup>26</sup>

N3A.152	<b>KISBY Sarah</b> [0997]	born c. 1802, Cambridge (Holy Sepulchre), Cambs., <sup>39</sup> though possibly the Sarah christened 1801, Cambridge (Holy Sepulchre), dau of “Thomas and Elizabeth”. <sup>40</sup> Unmarried, children seemingly born out of wedlock <sup>41</sup> Living with Thomas and Jane KISBY in 1841/1851. Working in an Upholsterer’s Shop (1851) and as a Needlewoman (1861) in Cambridge. died circa February 1866 age 64, Cambridge. <sup>42</sup>
